

Guidelines for M.Phil/Ph.D Entrance Exam Nov-2020

- The university will conduct the entrance test for the admission in Mphil/Ph.D course and the admission will be given to the candidates with higher merit (As per Selection Criteria*). There is no exemption for the applicants with NET/JRF or similar examination. However weightage will be given to such candidates (Selection Criteria).
- The syllabus for the Entrance test is same as UGC Net syllabus available on UGC website.
- Entrance test will be of 100 marks caring 2 parts PART-I (Common) and PART-II (Subject based). Each part will be comprised of 25 multiple-choice question carrying 2 marks each.
- M.phil Student from NIILM University Kaithal will be given extra weightage of 05 marks.
